- 1. Re-attaching the belting, this is the black stuff around the arena that keeps the dirt in. It is falling down in many areas and is a safety concern as a horse could trip over it and hurt themselves and their rider, we will need mostly lots of people, but also drills, shovels, rope, and wire cutters.
- 2. Painting the handicap ramp along the side of the announcer's booth. This is a big eyesore and needs to be repainted to make our arena look nice. We will need, people, paintbrushes, rollers, and paint trays.
- 3. Re-welding a couple of broken places on the arena fence. I know this is a long shot but if anyone has a handheld or portable welder, and knows how to weld we really need to get these areas rewelded.
- 4. Taking down all of our metal signs so they can be sanded and re-painted over the winter. For this we will just need people!
- 5. We are also in search of three 50 gallon plastic barrels to replace the barrels we have as they are starting to get in rough shape, if you or someone you know is able to get their hands on any, please let us know!
