From one year to the next, we always risk encountering an issue that may cause us not to be able to have a show as scheduled. This year has not been any different. In August, we unfortunately had to cancel the show due to the arena being too wet. The reschedule date is September 22nd. We thank each of you for understanding.

During our September meeting, we have decided to put on an Open 3D Poles and Open 3D Barrel Show. This show will be held at the Posey County Fairgrounds September 27th - just like our regular shows. The show is called "Short with a Sweet Pot" and will feature an added \$500. Each Office fee will be \$5 per person and each run will be \$20 per run. We will start at 5:00pm with exhibition runs at \$5 per run. The show will start at 7:00pm with Open 3D Poles and then Open 3D Barrels. This Show will be 80% payback with an added \$500. We hope to see you all on September 27th.

We have been asked to make sure that we do not allow any running of horses outside the arena. If you need to warm-up your horses, you may use the back arena where the 4-H Horse and Pony Blazing Saddles Club has their arena. Please do not run your horses around the newly planted trees or any of the trees. Please do not tie your horses to any of the trees. These trees are donated by Keck Gonnerman to the fairgrounds to provide shade and we do not want to do anything to harm them. Again, no running of horses outside the arena, this is a Posey County rule and you can be asked to leave the grounds by club officers or show administrators.

Please remember we are still in need of donations to help cover costs of operation and we are looking for donations for the awards banquet in January. Also, we are continually accepting donations for the purchase of the tractor.
